Cars – Two coaches provided by Union Station, one rented from private owner.

Here is a brief history of the two cars provided by Union Station.

Both started life as PRR 21 roomette sleepers. (Budd, lot 9667-024, plan 9513, 1949)

- SLRG 140 blt as PRR 8287 Tyrone Inn
- SLRG 146 blt as PRR 8247 Bucyrus Inn

In 1956 they were both converted to coaches #1524 and 1516 respectively. Cars became PC, then SEMTA, then MARC. Acquired 2011 by Iowa Pacific-San Luis & Rio Grande and assigned to Saratoga & North Creek.
